

BROOKLAND BAND BOOSTERS MEETING

Minutes for April 5, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 6:20 P.M. by Christy Wilson, President. Those in attendance were: Christy Wilson, Jo Hanke, Sherry Mobbs, Terry Hogard and Daphne Perkins.

Sherry Mobbs presented the Treasurer's report. Current balance \$1,094.05.

The car wash fundraiser was brought up. Christy never heard back from the parent who agreed to contact Auto Zone regarding the car wash. Sherry Mobbs agreed to contact Auto Zone at Hilltop to see if the Band Boosters could hold a car wash there on April 24, with the band students to do the washing and the boosters to oversee.

Christy advised that it appeared there would not be a Brookland Downtown Celebration. Jo advised that this was the case because Shelby, who works for the City, was too busy. Other boosters advised that it appears the city will have a Fall Festival. It was discussed that the band boosters should try to work with the city to help Shelby and also so the boosters do not lose the Fall Festival as a fundraiser. Christy will contact Shelby to see if the City will allow the Band Boosters to assist for a share of profits.

The year end concert was discussed, as well as ideas for items to try to obtain for silent auction to be held that night. Discussed putting together a package with the Red Bird tickets to sell chances rather than auctioning them off.

Also decided to sell water bottles and plastic cups again to raise additional funds at the final concert.

The awards ceremony will be held on May 14. The boosters will once again supply pizza which will be free for band students and their siblings in grades 4 and lower. Everyone else will be required to pay \$5 each. Sherry will contact Pizza 4 Less in Paragould regarding prices, and Christy will contact Tropical Twist in Brookland for price. Anticipate needing 50-60 pizzas. RC Bottling of Paragould sent several canned sodas already and Sherry will see about getting more for the dinner that evening.

Daphne Perkins made a motion seconded by Sherry Mobbs that we suspend the bylaws with regard to band scholarships for the coming summer. Motion passed. Anyone receiving a band camp scholarship will be required to provide proof that they attended after camp, and parents will be reimbursed at that time. The amounts are to be decided at the May meeting.

Several boosters were nominated for offices, but none accepted their nominations except for one. It was decided that the election of officers would be placed on the May meeting agenda.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:16 p.m. by Christy Wilson.
