

BROOKLAND BAND BOOSTERS MEETING

Minutes for December 7, 2009

Meeting was called to order at 6:20 P.M. by Christy Wilson, President. Those in attendance were: Christy Wilson, Jo Hanke, Terry Hogard, Sherry Mobbs, Daphne Perkins & Autumn Osier.

The November meeting minutes were unavailable as the secretary was not present at the meeting.

Treasurer's reports for November and December were submitted by Sherry Mobbs, treasurer. Sherry advised that the check written to us by the food vendor for the Fall Festival had been returned due to insufficient funds. After several attempts to resolve the matter informally, she was forced to turn the check over to the prosecuting attorney in Greene County.

Items discussed at the meeting included snacks to be provided to the band after practices daily that week after practicing for Christmas parade and refreshments to be provided by parents for reception after Christmas concert.

Christy advised that the gift-wrapping idea presented last month as a fundraiser fell through due to lack of participation/response.

Christy advised about the Goodsearch/Goodshop account set up online for the Band Boosters. If Goodsearch is used to search for items on the internet, the boosters will make about 1 cent per search. Christy also advised if anyone does any online shopping that they utilize the Goodshop portion of the website; by clicking the link to certain online vendors after visiting the Goodshop website, a certain percentage of each sale will go to the boosters. Using the website requires that you first select Brookland Band Boosters as your charity before you utilize it for searching/shopping.

Mr. Hogard advised that there was a \$100 profit from Christmas ornament sales.

Sherry received a fundraising idea from Chick-Fil-A. The fundraising item being sold was cheesecakes at a total of \$20 each with the booster to make \$8 each from the sales. It was decided to go ahead & try to sell these prior to Christmas since there was no expense to the boosters. Christy is to email out order forms to members.

Expenses to expect for the month of January include Senior High Region tryouts and All Region – State. Mr. Hogard advised that Dillan Lawrence, Jacob Perkins and Perri Wright made Junior High All Region, and Carson Harris, Rachel Stewart and James McClellan were Junior High All Region Alternates.

Sherry advised that she has not received a paper bank statement in the mail since July. Christy will contact the band booster parent who works for our bank and see if she can assist with this problem.

Christy asked if anyone would have any objection to the January meeting being held on the 4th, which is the day most everyone returns after Christmas break to school and work. Everyone was in agreement to leave the meeting time as January 4.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:51 p.m. by Christy Wilson.
