MINUTES of Regular Meeting
May 5, 2009
Band Room

The May meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Vice-President (acting President) Pam Mullins.

Members in attendance were Pam Mullins, Sherry Mobbs, Tina Gentry, Terry Hogard (Band Director), Charles Harris, Mecca Baxter, Christy Wilson and Mr. Perkins.

The April minutes had no corrections. The minutes were approved as submitted by Tina Gentry.

Treasurer Sherry Mobbs reported a total of \$942.72 currently in the bank. Money planned on being used is around \$180.00 for trophies and plaques for the year end award ceremony. Mr. Hogard will purchase certificates from the Activity Account.

The Downtown Celebration is May 16 from 10 am - 3pm. Booth will need to be set up by 9:30. Several attending the meeting agreed to volunteer and work at the booth.

The Awards Ceremony will be held May 15 in the cafeteria. A motion was made by Sherry Mobbs that the Band Boosters pay for the pizza for dinner, and this motion was seconded by Mr. Harris. Motion passed. Further discussion followed, with a decision to allow band members to eat for free; other family members would need to pay \$5.00 for their meal.

Mr. Hogard advised that he needed two chaperones for the game night to follow the awards ceremony, preferably one female and one male. Game night will end at 10:30 pm.

Band camp scholarships were discussed. Mr. Hogard advised that 7 students planned on going to band camp. A motion was made by Mr. Harris and seconded by Mr. Perkins that we pay \$50.00 per student, with Mr. Hogard to decide the allotment for each, toward band camp scholarships. Motion passed. It was decided that if the silent auction at the Downtown Celebration was profitable, another meeting would be held to decide how much more could possibly be given toward band camp scholarships.

The proposed amendments were the next item on the agenda. After much discussion, a motion was made to forego the proposed changes/amendments at this time, and was seconded. Motion passed. It was decided that a committee would be formed by the incoming president who would look over the bylaws and make recommendations of

changes/additions to the Band Boosters.

Election of officers for 2009-10 were the next item. A motion was made by Mr. Harris and seconded by Ms. Wilson, that the current officers remain in their current positions. These include: Vice-President: Pam Mullins, Secretary: Tina Gentry, and Treasurer: Sherry Mobbs. Motion passed.

It was announced that the nominees for the office of President were Christy Wilson and Charles Harris. After taking a vote of the membership, Christy Wilson was elected President for the 2009-10 year.

A reception to follow the year end band concert on May 17 was discussed. Sherry Mobbs will send out emails asking for food donations for the reception.

Next meeting date will be discussed and decided upon by the incoming officers. Mr. Hogard suggested no meeting would be needed in June.

Hearing no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
