

BROOKLAND BAND BOOSTERS MEETING
Minutes for October 5, 2009

Meeting was called to order at 6:20 P.M. by Christy Wilson, President. Those in attendance were: Christy Wilson, Jo Hanke, Terry Hogard, Lisa McClellan, Bertha Doyle, Samantha Doyle and Shelia Easley.

The September meeting minutes were approved as submitted by CeJae Hanke.

Treasurers report was not given as Sherry Mobbs, treasurer, could not attend the meeting due to illness.

The main item on the agenda was the Fall Festival to be held on Saturday, October 24 in the Middle School Parking lot. The following items were discussed:

Band Boosters would have the follow games/booths: Ring toss, Tattoo/face painting, Pick up ducks, Bean Bag toss and/or plinko, and a booth to be prepared and ran by Laura Shipman. Game prices were discussed and decided upon. The idea of selling tickets was discussed but discarded since we were not sure if others who had rented booths would have games.

Volunteers for games: Lisa McClellan agreed to be a floater. Shelia Easley advised her husband could be a floater.

Southern Bank donated \$50. It was decided that the band boosters would sell chances to win the \$50 for \$1.00 per chance. Winner to be drawn at the festival but need not be present to win.

Fliers to promote festival - it was decided to send notes home with grades K - 6 only. Christy agreed to notify the Jr. and Sr. High secretaries asking them to place on announcements. Jo was to contact KAIT to place on community calendar. Shelia was to contact Triple FM to appear at the Community Breakfast if possible on the Wednesday before the festival.

Other items discussed with regard to the fall festival: how to print fliers, more booth ideas, obtaining prizes from local businesses, change for booths, costume contest.

Shelia Easley agreed to take over as Band Booster secretary for the remainder of the year.

Mr. Hogard then presented an idea for a fund raiser but was not sure if he wanted the boosters to head it up, or if the band themselves would do it. The items for sale would be personalized "Bearcat" Christmas ornaments. He will let us know how he wishes to proceed.
